Meet Conditions

1. This event will be swum Short Course. Starts from the bulkhead at the middle of the pool. Care must be taken when diving. Pool depth at the start end is 2.0m and 1.2m at turn end. (Note: pool depth decrease approx 7m from the start end.)
2. All events mixed time finals. The meet will be swum under SNZ, FINA and local rules, with over the top starts.

3. Maximum of 3 events per swimmer. Organisers reserve the right to amend the programme if necessary, and to restrict entries.
4. Entries via the SNZ Database and close at 23:59.59 (midnight) on Saturday 23 June 2018. Age is at 30 June 2018. Open to SNZ registered club and competitive swimmers. NTs are permitted.
5. Para swimmers are eligible to compete at this meet and must present their classification card to the Meet Referee prior to the commencement of the meet.
6. Entry fee \$10.00 per event. Payment must be made at the time of entry via Swimming NZ online (requires credit/debit card). No refunds for withdrawals after the entries close on Saturday 23 June 2018. Pirates Swim Team is not GST Registered.
7. All scratchings will close by midday on the Friday prior to the start of the meet.
8. Marshalling will operate for this meet (in Spin Room adjacent to the deep end of the pool).
9. Entry to the pool during warm-up to be FEET FIRST via the shallow end (except dive lanes). Dive lanes will operate from the bulkhead end in LANES 0 AND 9 ONLY for the final 10 minutes of warm-up. Coaches are to monitor warm-up.
10. Team Managers' Meeting will be held at 4.45pm in the marshalling room. Officials meeting will be held 5.15pm.
11. Strapping of muscles/joints is not permitted unless supported by a Doctor or Physio certificate and sighted by the Meet Referee prior to the start of the meet.
12. Entry to WRAC is via the main entrance. Swimming Wellington pool entry passes are to be used by officials, swimmers, coaches and team managers. \$2 door entry fee to be paid by all spectators. Programmes \$2.
13. Organisers will not be liable for any loss or damage during the period of the meet. All participants must agree to comply with the Sports' Anti-Doping Rules.
14. Swimming Wellington Photography Policy applies.
