- This event will be swum Short Course and the start end will be from the deep end. Please note the pool depth is 1.2m –2m. Care is required when diving. Entry to the pool during warm-up will be feet first only (except authorised sprint lanes).
- The meet will be swum under SNZ/FINA rules, with over the top starts and local rules.
- A Team Managers' meeting will be held 10 minutes prior to the start of warm up.
- Age is at 9 February 2019. Open to SNZ registered competitive swimmers, apart from club events 9, 10, 17, 18, 31 & 32 which are open to SNZ registered "club swimmers" only. Heats for club events will be capped to the top 14 swimmers in each and ribbons will be awarded.
- Para swimmers are eligible to compete at this meet and must present their classification card to the Referee prior to the commencement of the meet.
- Events will be swum as open timed finals but medals will be awarded to the first three place-getters in the following age groups: 9 & U, 10-11, 12-13, 14-15 and 16 & over. 4th-7th places will receive a ribbon. There will be medal presentations after events 12 & 32 and at the end of each session. A same gender representative may stand in to collect a medal if the recipient is unavailable.
- Event 39 & 40: Champion of Champions (7 fastest swimmers from Events 29 & 30 compete). A trophy is awarded to the first competitive Wairarapa

swimmer in each event. (If a swimmer from outside the region wins, they shall be awarded a medal for 1st place).

- Entries will be via the SNZ Database. Entries close 23:59.59 (midnight) on Friday 1<sup>st</sup> of February 2019.
- Entry fees are \$10 per event, payment online by credit card.
- There will be no refunds for withdrawals after the entries close on Friday 1<sup>st</sup> of February 2019.
- 1 NT per session for 100m, 200m, or 400m, events. No NTs for 50m events.
- Strapping of muscles/joints is not permitted unless supported by a Doctor or Physio certificate and sighted by the Referee prior to the start of the meet.
- There is no GST component to entry fees for this meet.
- Entry to the Trust House Recreation Centre is via the Main Entrance for all swimmers, officials and spectators.
- Programmes available at cost of \$2 per session.
- The organisers will not be liable for any loss or damage during the period of the meet. All participants must agree to comply with the sport's anti-doping rules.
- The organisers reserve the right to amend the programme if necessary, and to restrict entries
- Participants who have entered this event agree to allow images (e.g. photography, video, etc.) to be taken by accredited media approved by SW.
