

7. Boys 12/13yrs 4x50m freestyle relay
8. Girls 14yrs and over 4x50m freestyle relay
9. Boys 14yrs and over 4x50m freestyle relay
10. 50 Breaststroke
11. 25 Butterfly (Novice)*
12. 50 Butterfly
13. Boys &/or Girls 9yrs & U 4x25m medley relay
14. Boys &/or Girls 10/11yrs 4x50m medley relay
15. Boys &/or Girls 12/13yrs 4x50m medley relay
16. Boys &/or Girls 14yrs & O 4x50m medley relay
17. 50 Freestyle
18. Flying Squadron relay 8x50m freestyle relay
 (one boy and one girl from each age group.)

Note; The organisers reserves the right to alter the order and/or combine events.

All individual races will be mixed races, swum slowest to fastest.

There will be no diving from the shallow end in the Novice 25 butterfly or the 9 and under relays.

On-line entries through the SNZ database for individual events close at midnight, Sunday 20 Nov.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- The meet will be swum under SNZ/FINA and local rules
- Maximum swims - two individual events. No times will be accepted.
- Those achieving a Personal Best will receive a PB ribbon and a Chocolate Bar.
- Clubs with four or more entrants will be awarded points on a percentage basis for Personal Best swum in individual events. The winning club will win the Best time Trophy.
- All participants must agree to comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Rules
- Classified Para swimmers are eligible to compete at this meet. are eligible to compete at this meet and shall compete under the IPC Swimming Rules. Para swimmers must report to the Technical Director prior to warm up.
- By entering this event swimmers agree to allow images (e.g. photography, video, etc.) to be taken by accredited media approved by Swimming Wellington. Images are only to be used for legitimate purposes by Swim Wellington or Gold Coast clubs in accordance with SNZ's Member Protection Policy.
- Strapping on a swimmer is not permitted unless sighted prior to the meet by the Technical Director and supported by a doctors/physio certificate.

WARM UP RULES: Warm up lanes will be allocated by the organisers on the night based on club entries. Coaches and Team Managers are responsible for swimmers' safety during the warm up. Diving will be permitted in any lane from the deep end only under coach supervision from 3:15pm. Swimmers must not swim back to the deep end during diving and are to exit the pool from the shallow end or at the side.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR PAEKAKARIKI SHIELD RELAY ENTRIES (Relay entries will be taken at the meet)

- Age is as at the date of the meet. All club members are eligible for relay selection.
- Swimmers must swim in their own age group – there will be no swimming up/down and no exhibition swims. Swimmers may be entered into as many relay events as they are eligible for but can only swim once in each event.
- Clubs may enter more than one relay team in each event, naming the teams 'A,B,C etc'. Only the A team will score.
- Clubs are to write up an entry card for each relay team, showing the event number, event name (9yrs &U boys Free) team name (Tawa A etc) and the swimmers names and dates of birth. These are to be submitted by 3.15pm
- Points will be awarded as follows; 4x25m 6,5,4,3,2,1. 8X25m 8,6,4,3,2,1.

Duties: Clubs are to provide officials names as listed to Elouise Thomas (PCA Officials Co-ord.) at officials@swimporirua.co.nz by Mon.21 Nov.

- Timekeepers PCA and Tawa 6 each. Otaki & Raumati 4 each
- Qualified IOTs and Trainees are welcome. Names to be supplied
- One person from each club to assist at the desk
