1. The meet is an 'all in' event for all swim membership categories.

2. The meet is a designated meet, run according to SNZ, FINA and local rules. If there are insufficient qualified officials the meet status will not be designated, and the times will not be official.

3. Meet will be run as mixed timed finals with over-the-top starts.

4. Age is at 10 December 2022

5. This meet is First-Come-First-Served entry. If oversubscribed, entries submitted last will be rejected. Time ribbons given to all 12 and under swimmers.

6. The meet is short course. All times must be held on the SNZ database, converted times are permissible. NT (No Times) will be accepted.

7. All participants must agree to comply with Sport NZ anti-doping rules.

8. Swimzone Racing Club reserves the right to cancel the meet, restrict entries, combine entries, or alter the programme.

9. Entry fee is \$25. Each swimmer can choose up to 4 races. Payment must be made at the time of entry via Swimming NZ Fastlane https://fastlane.swimming.org.nz/login.

10. Entries close at 10pm on Sun 4 December 2022.11. Withdrawals will be accepted until 12pm, Fri 9 December at race@szr.co.nz. Refunds will be considered on application to the Meet organiser.

12. The organisers will not be responsible for any loss or damage during the meet.

13. Initial psych sheets and a session report will be posted to Facebook and the club website by Thurs prior to the meet. Any errors must be advised to race@szr.co.nz by Fri 9 December at 12pm. 14. Para swimmers (including provisional classification) are eligible to compete at this meet.

15. Any tape used for strapping of muscles/joints must be approved by the Meet Referee prior to the start of the meet (and be accompanied with a Dr/Physio certificate).16. Care is required when diving. Feet first entry during warm-up only (except authorised sprint lanes at the allocated times).

17. Events will be marshalled from the slide area. All swimmers need to sit in the Team Manager area.
Swimmers choosing not to sit with the team are responsible for getting themselves to marshalling.
18. Protests will be subject to SNZ policy # 008. Protests must be submitted to the referee, in writing, on the protest form by the Team Manager only, within 30 minutes following the conclusion of the respective event. This needs to be accompanied in cash by the \$100 protest fee.

 Please adhere to the Govt and Hutt Council Covid restrictions applicable on 10 December 2022.
 Printed programmes supplied to Team Coaches/Team Managers: 1-20 swimmers (2); 11-20 swimmers (4), 21 plus (6).

21. Participants who have entered this event agree to allow images (e.g. photography, video, etc.) to be taken by accredited media approved by Swimming Wellington. 22. Initial results will show on Meet Mobile App. Subject to approval, unofficial results will be available shortly as approved times in the SNZ database. 25m races will not be added to the database.
